- Boldly steps out of their comfort zone in faith to do what God has called them to
- · Abides in Christ in every season of life
- Displays love and humility towards everyone especially those they disagree with
- Discerns and rightly interprets the word of truth
- Denies themselves and puts the work of God before their own satisfaction
